

MYBSL Boys All Star Selection Procedures: Revised January 2011

In order to select the most deserving players and coaches for the Boys All Star Teams, the MYBSL Board has adopted the following procedure for selection of coaches and players.

1. An MYBSL Board of Directors and the All Star Sub Committee shall oversee the selection process.
2. The All Star Committee shall be made up of the MYBSL President and four other MYBSL Board Members.
 - a. The President shall appoint the four other committee members.
 - b. The committee members shall NOT have a direct interest in the selection.
 - i. Direct interest is defined but not limited to having submitted their name as being a potential manager or coach or having a child on a player's ballot.
 - c. The All Star Committee may invite any persons if deems necessary to assist them.
 - i. Additional members will act in advisory roles only and will not have voting rights.
3. MYBSL shall send four teams in the following:
 - a. 11- 12 Yrs. Old LL
 - b. 10 - 11 Yrs. Old LL
 - c. 9 – 10 Yrs. Old LL
 - d. Brian Stone Team 11-12 Yrs. Old.
4. The committee will solicit interest from any and all coaches, assistant coaches and players.
 - a. Interested coaches must submit their interest in writing prior to the official opening day.
 - b. Interested players must submit their interest online through registration or through the forms sent home with all players; interest must be submitted prior to the official opening day.
5. The committee shall complete four lists (ballots) of eligible players in the following manner. Players name will appear on more than one ballot if eligible.
 - a. All players 11 years old and older will be placed on a ballot for the 11-12 year old team.
 - b. All players 10 and 11 years old will be placed on a second ballot.
 - c. All players 9 and 10 years old will be place on a third ballot.
 - d. All players 11-12 having interest in the Brian Stone Team will be placed on a forth ballot.
6. All Head and Assistant Coaches will vote by closed written ballot.
 - a. They shall vote for twelve (12) players on each ballot.
 - b. Major League coaches will vote for players on the first ballot.
 - c. Major League coaches will vote for players on the second ballot. (Coaches should not take into account any votes on the first ballot.)
 - d. Minor League Coaches will vote for players on the third ballot.
 - e. The committee will tally ballots one and two and remove any selected players from the Brian Stone ballot.
 - f. Major League Coaches will then vote for players on the Brian Stone ballot.
7. The committee will move into a closed session at which time they will.
 - a. Consider and assign team Managers and / or Coaches.
 - b. Tally Player Ballots and develop team rosters as follows:
 - i. The top 12 players with the highest number of votes for the 11-12 year old team will be placed on that team.
 - ii. The names of any 11 year old players that have been placed on the 11-12 year old team will be removed from the 10 - 11 year old ballot and the next top 12 players with the highest number of votes for the 10 - 11 year old team will be placed on that team.
 - iii. The names of any 10 year old players that have been placed on the 10-11 year old team will be removed from the 9 - 10 year old ballot and the next top 12 players with the highest number of votes for the 9-10 year old team will be placed on that team.
 - iv. The names of any 11-12 year old players that have been placed on the 11-12 year old or the 10 - 11 year old teams will be removed from the Brian Stone ballot and the next top 12 players with the highest number of votes for the Brian Stone team will be placed on that team.
8. All Star Team Rosters will be made public according to Little League Rules.
9. The All Star committee may at its discretion rule on any circumstance not covered by this procedure.
